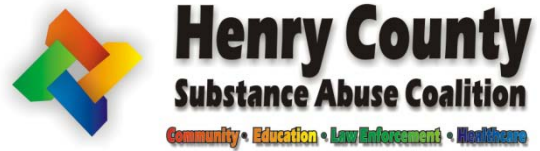

I. Strategic Planning Continued: Strategy Selection and Check

This month's Coalition meeting focused on the Strategies associated with each Goal Area.
